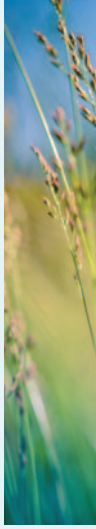

TRANSFORMING BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

There has never been a greater demand in our community for access to behavioral health and substance abuse services. Approximately 670,000 people in our service area have anticipated behavioral health outpatient needs. Unfortunately, as the need for services continues to grow, funding for these services has been cut dramatically. As a result, patients are seeking care in emergency rooms or often waiting days for treatment in a psychiatric facility.

With support from philanthropy, Atrium Health – which serves as the safety net provider for behavioral health services in the region – is addressing these needs. From funding behavioral health integration in primary care, to virtual care and peripartum depression programs, philanthropy continues to make a tremendous impact.
