- Skin cancer is the most common cancer.
- More skin cancers are diagnosed in the United States each year than all other cancers combined.
- Melanoma accounts for only about 1% of skin cancers but causes a large majority of skin cancer deaths.
- An estimated **100,350** new cases* of melanoma will be diagnosed this year.
- The rates of melanoma have been rising for the last 30 years.
- It is one of the most common cancers in young adults, especially in young women.
- The risk of melanoma increases as people age.

The most important way to lower your risk of melanoma is to protect yourself from exposure to UV rays. Practice sun safety when you are outdoors. Simply staying in the shade is one of the best ways to limit your UV exposure. If you are going to be in the sun, wear protective clothing, use sunscreen, wear a hat and sunglasses.
