Dr. Moshiree served as Associate Professor of Medicine and Director of Motility in the Division of Gastroenterology at the University of Miami Miller School of Medicine.

Chronic gastrointestinal illnesses includes complex esophageal disorders, gastroparesis, intestinal pseudo-obstruction, irritable bowel syndrome (IBS) and constipation.
