


Vision

Atrium Health Behavioral Health Service Line will develop a transformative, clinically integrated, and sustainable system of high-quality, patient-and family-centered care to serve the Behavioral Health needs of patients, their families and the community.



Facility Overview

- State of the Art Inpatient Psychiatric Hospital opened on April 7, 2014
- 66-bed acute psychiatric inpatient facility for adults
- 3 nursing units with all private rooms
- Primary clinical focus is for the treatment of mood disorders such as major depression and bipolar disorder
- One unit devoted to dual-diagnosis treatment for patients with acute psychiatric illness and co-occurring substance abuse issues
- One unit specializes in maternal wellness for women struggling with mental illness during pregnancy
- Hospitalists work 7 days on/7 days off, Tuesday Monday
- Peer support specialists provide patient perspective to team, education for patients and serve as patient advocate and role model of recovery.



Facility Amenities

- Comfort Lounges on each nursing unit provide patients with a space to decompress and practice coping skills
- On site gymnasium provides space for physical activity through recreational therapy
- Inner courtyard with walking labyrinth allows patients to go outside and participate in therapies while enjoying nature
- Discharge readiness group helps prepare patient for transition to outpatient setting



2022 Highlights

- Cared for 2,836 patients in our inpatient units and cared for 11,084 in outpatient visits
- Inpatient Occupancy rate = 92.5%
- Average Length of Stay = 7.5 days

Thanks to the Levine Family's generosity, we:

- Reprinted behavioral health workbooks that are integral to patient/group therapy
- Purchased Recreational Therapy and Occupational Therapy supplies used in individual and group therapy
- Maintained a supply of Code Lavender interventions to assist with staff stress and compassion fatigue
- Added a picnic and respite area on the campus
- Installed Security podium in front lobby to enhance services for patients, visitors, and teammates

Carolinas Psychiatry and Behavioral Wellness Outpatient Care

- Adult, child and adolescent outpatient therapy by clinical therapists and psychiatrists
- Peripartum/postpartum behavioral health group therapy program started in August 2017
- Psychological testing available
- ECT and TMS consultation and assessment available

Electroconvulsive Therapy

- Inpatients at the Mindy Ellen Levine Behavioral Health Center can receive evaluation, assessment and initiation of ECT
- Patients are transported to Atrium Health Huntersville outpatient surgery center for initiation of therapy
- Therapy continues as outpatient



Maternal Wellness Program

An innovative wellness program for mothers during and after pregnancy




- Established in August 2017, the program aims to decrease the mother's stress and increase her positive thoughts and behaviors.
- Weekly group therapy and individual counseling for expecting and new moms
- Virtual Program offered during pandemic, allowing moms and babies to stay safely in their homes and still receive supportive care

Highlight

85% increase in Maternal Wellness Program participants from 2021 to 2022, attributed to maintaining the option of virtual counseling
